

Ring Size Guide & Sparkles

How to find your ring size

Print out this Ring Size Guide. Make sure this guide is printed in the actual size and that Page scaling is set to none.

Select one of the following methods to find your ring size:

- **Method 1:** Find your size by measuring the diameter of your finger. Use this method if you're in possession of a ring that fits the intended finger.
- **Method 2:** Find your size by measuring the circumference of your finger. Use this method if you aren't in possession of a fitting ring.
- **Method 3:** Find your size by using the conversion table. Use this method if you already know your ring size, but you don't know your size in US standards.

Method 1: Measure the diameter using a ring that fits

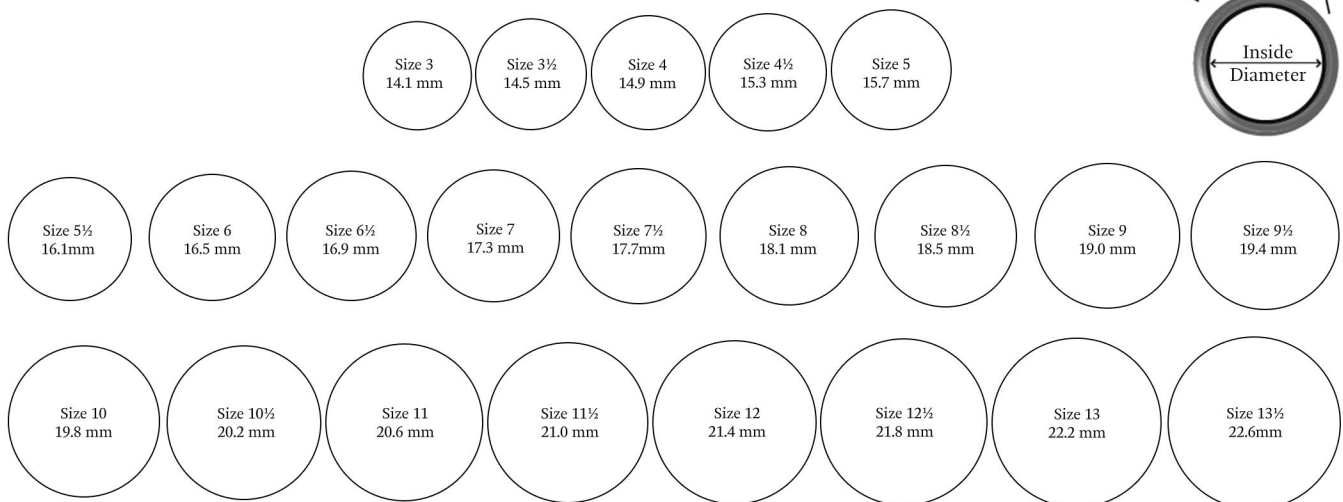
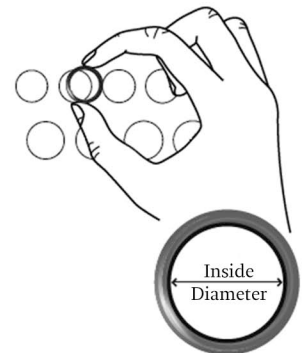
1. Remember that ring measurements are very precise, so check that the printed bar is exactly 50mm or 2 inches long. Disable all page scaling options when printing.



Make sure the printed bar is exactly 50mm or 2 inches long.



2. Select a ring that properly fits the intended finger. Make sure it is a ring that is worn on the same finger you want to buy a ring for.
3. Place the ring over the circles below. Match the inside diameter of the ring to the circle nearest in size. If the ring falls between two sizes, order the larger size.
4. The size displayed above the diameter is your ring size. Use this size in your order.

Method 2: Measure the circumference using the sizer

1. Remember that ring measurements are very precise, so check that the printed bar is exactly 50mm or 2 inches long. Disable all page scaling options when printing.

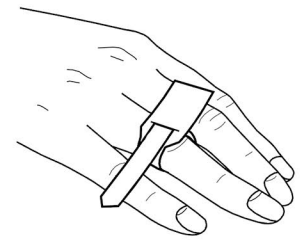
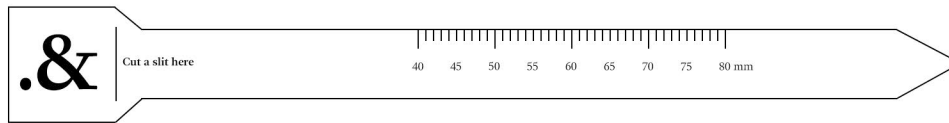


Make sure the printed bar is exactly 50mm or 2 inches long.



2. Carefully cut along the outline of the sizer and make a small slit in its left hand side.
3. Wrap the sizer around the intended finger and slide the pointed end through the slit.
4. Move the sizer to the larger part of the finger like the knuckle and pull tightly. The sizer must fit snugly to produce an accurate size.
5. Find the right size by matching the measured circumference with the correct size using the conversion table on the next page. If the ring falls between two sizes, order the larger size.

Example: The circumference of your finger is 57mm. Your US ring size is 8.



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Method 3 Find your size by converting your size to US standards.
